

Proceeding of District Development Coordination & Monitoring Committee (Disha) meeting held on 13-08-2016 at 12.00 Noon in DAC Meeting Hall, Mini Sectt., Hisar under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble M.P. Lok Sabha Sh. Dushyant Chautala, Hisar

The list of participants is enclosed.

It was the first meeting of Disha committee scheduled by Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India. At the outset of the meeting, the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Hisar welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman, Sh. Dushyant Chautala M.P, Lok Sabha, Hisar. All the members of District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee also welcomed the Chairman as well.

Being the introductory meeting Chairman issued the following direction to be implemented in the next meeting.

- Apart from the defined programmes in the guidelines of DISHA the Hon'ble Chairman directed that all the programmes which were in District Vigilance & Monitoring Committee be included in next DISHA meeting. Apart from this the functionaries who deal with any State/Central Scheme/Programme will also be included in the next agenda for review and monitoring of the programmes of these schemes/programme.
- The Hon'ble Chairman issue the direction that all the concerned department/institutions/organizations/agencies will submit their report within a week regarding the details of all programmes (State/Central) schemes/policy etc along with parameters of review, monitoring and implementation of the same in requisite formats. He further directed that all the concerned departments/agencies/institutions/organizations etc. shall provide a detailed synopsis of the resources available with them along with particulars of 'manpower' requirements specifically referring to the staff position (sanctioned/unsanctioned posts) whether filled-up/ vacant posts (regular/contractual/temporary/outsourced/adhoc etc) so that the appropriate authority may be appraised of the same for needful action and successful implementation of the said programmes/ schemes.
- The Hon'ble Chairman nominated three members who were already nominated to be the members of erstwhile District Vigilance and Monitoring Committee which is superseded by DISHA, while the nomination of a members of ST Category is concerned, the needful shall be done in the near future.



Item No. 1 Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Programme (MGNREGA)

The progress under MGNREGA for the year 2015-16 was viewed as satisfactory by the house. APO, MGNREGA further appraised the house that against the total available funds Rs. 2434.37 lacs an expenditure to the tune of Rs. 3419.01 lacs have been incurred during the financial year 2015-16 under MGNREGA and similarly in the current financial year 2016-17 against available funds Rs. 573.61 lacs an expenditure to the tune of Rs. 709.20 lacs have been incurred. The Chairman directed all the Implementing Agencies to submit the proposal/ estimates of your departments, the works to be executed under MGNREGA Convergence. Specially the Chairman has directed DFO (T) to submit the proposal regarding plantation works under MGNREGA convergence as the monsoon season is near and also directed the XEN, HSAMB, Hisar for submission of proposal of estimates of the roads earth work of breams. The Chairman also directed to BD&PO, Narnaund to take up the works of pond in village Mirchpur. The Additional Deputy Commissioner -cum-Additional District Project Coordinator directed all the BD&POs and all the officers of line department to achieve the target as per labour budget for the year 2016-17.

Item No. 2 Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G)

The Hon'ble Chairman directed all the concerned BDPOs and officials to submit a report within a week for the progress of work done in this scheme.

Item No. 3 Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana (NRLM)

Hon'ble Chairman has directed to take the scheme very seriously and the concerned officer i.e. DPM, IISRLM, Hisar was directed to link the scheme with Skill India and also include SHGs for women and submit a report in this regard. The DPM, NRLM was directed in the meeting of DVMC held on 16-06-2016 that a sale counter of biscuits prepared from Bajra by SHGs and the same should be available in all official meetings. The DPM was himself not present in the meeting and he is being directed to submit a report within a week on this issue.

Item No. 4 National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM)

The concerned appraised the House that this scheme is being implemented in two blocks namely Narnaund and Hisar-1 Blocks of Hisar District. After reviewing the the progress of the scheme the Chairman directed that such activities like making bags, files cover etc. be selected and used by Govt. Officer. The DPM may also submit the list of such activities of products in the villages before the next meeting.

Item No. 5 Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM-Gramin)

The progress under the programme was considered satisfactory by the house. The Chairman has directed to provide the list of SBM along with detail of all 12 Motivator to the members of DISHA, Sh. Kapil and Vikrant Bagri who will check and inspection the toilets constructed during the year 2016-17 upto date and list may also be provided to all MLAs. The XEN, PR, Hisar has also assured the house that efforts

are being made to complete the 25 Solid & Liquid Waste Management Projects will be completed very shortly.

The Consultant SBM (G) further appraised the house that all strenuous efforts are being made to motivate the public in the village for the cleanliness and sensitization about the Swaccha Bharat Mission (Gramin) and 133 villages has been declared ODF. The balance financial/ physical target will be achieved before the close of financial year.

Item No. 6 Deen Dayal Upadhyay- Gramin Kaushalya Yojna (DDU-GKY)

Hon'ble Chairman directed the concerned to include Nehru Yuva Kendra for skill development and submit the progress report in this regard.

Item No. 7 Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojna (DDUGJY)

The concerned officer appraised the house that DPR in this regard is ready to start the work after completing the necessary formalities of tender etc.

Item No. 8 Ujjwal DISCOM Assurance Yojana (UDAY)

Hon'ble Chairman directed that MD, DHBVNL will be personally present in the next meeting and submit a detail report of line loss of Rural/Urban areas and what necessary steps are being taken to prevent that.

Item No. 9 Pradhan Mantri UJJWALA Yojana(PMUY)-LPG Connection to BPL families

The report appraised was satisfactory.

ItemNo. 10 National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP).

The concerned was directed by the Chairman for checking the proper distribution of Pension to the beneficiaries and submit a report in this regard within a week.

Item No. 11 Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Housing for All- Urban)

The concerned was directed to submit a detail survey report about the programme.

Item No. 12 Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM-Urban)

The concerned was directed to submit a detail survey report about the programme along with the utilization of funds and also a status report about the construction of Cycle Track in the city.



Item No. 13 Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Urban Mission (NRUM)

The Scheme did not relate to Hisar District. 1

Item No. 14 National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY)

The Chairman directed to include Deputy Director Archeology, BDPO, Narnaund regarding Rakhi Garhi and BDPO, Agroha regarding Agroha to maintain the Archeology sites.

Item No. 15 Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

The concerned appraised the house that a sum of Rs. 409 Crore has been released and the chairman directed to submit a report within a week in this regard.

Item No. 16 Infrastructure related programmes like Telecom, railways, highways, waterways, mines etc.

The Chairman directed that the all concerned GM, BSNL, GM Railways, Project Director, NHAI be invited in the next meeting and they may be asked a submit a report within a week regarding status of their work.

Item No. 17 National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP)

The concerned appraised the house that a sum of Rs. 193 Crore has been received for this scheme and the Chairman directed to provide the copy of guidelines at the earliest.

Item No. 18 Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY)-

The Chairman asked for the copy of DIP submitted and the latest status report of action taken in this regard.

Item No. 19 Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).

The Hon'ble Chairman has taken the issue very seriously and asked the concerned to submit the report within a week about how much percentage of the beneficiary adopted the scheme.

Item No. 20 Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP)

The concerned appraised the house that a Rs. 50 Lac has been received and the Hon'ble Chairman were satisfied about the progress of the scheme.



Item No. 21 Digital India Land Record Modernization Programme (NLRMP)

The concerned appraised the house that 100% digitization of land record has been completed. The Hon'ble Chairman directed the concerned to submit a written report on the percentage of completion of work within a week.

Item No. 22 National Health Mission (NHM)

The Hon'ble Chairman directed the concerned to do the needful for providing the fuel in the preview of Gram Panchayat for the fogging machine and submit a report in this regard about the action taken. Further they were also directed that CMO and Dy. Director Archeology make coordination for the maintenance of Post Mortem house in Civil Hospital, Hisar as there is some issue with the Archeology Department and both the officers were directed to submit the report of the action taken in this regard.

Item No. 23 Sarva Siksha Abhiyan (SSA)

The concerned appraised the house regarding the scheme and Hon'ble Chairman asked the concerned regarding the Bi-Cycle distributed to the girls students DPC, Hisar told the house that the budget for the Bi-Cycles has been provided to DEEO, Hisar.

Item No. 24 Integrated Child Development Scheme (ICDS)

Hon'ble Chairman directed that the concerned departments of WCD & Health shall work in tandem to address the serious issued of malnutrition in the district.

Item No. 25 Mid-Day-Meal Schemes.

Hon'ble Chairman took it very seriously as to that how a class I officer may be so negligent and may remain absent from a meeting of national importance. Moreover, it was a matter of great concern that the representative deputed by you to attend the meeting was neither well versed with the schemes of the department nor reply to the queries up to the level of satisfaction raised by Hon'ble Chairman. Further, the deputed person was also directed to submit the report within a week in the office of undersigned which are still awaited and disappointing to say the least. Altogether the non compliance of order and non seriousness of your working gives your intension of negligence and negative attitude of your working in the office which may damage the welfare of the students. Further DEEO, Hisar may also be directed to submit a report regarding the cleanliness and distribution of Mid-Day Meal. He further instructed that special campaigns be organized at Block and Cluster Levels for distribution of Bi-Cycles.



Item No. 26 Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)

The Hon'ble Chairman took a very serious note on the scheme and was not satisfied by the details appraised by the concerned officer. He was directed to submit a report along with the guidelines within a week indicating the status of last five years monitoring report of works under PMGSY and explain your position why you did not follow the guidelines of the scheme and also explain his position in this regard as to why the progress of the said scheme/ programme was neither intimated nor apprised to the competent authority.

Item No. 27 Jal Marg Vikash Project

It does not relate to Hisar District.

Item No. 28 Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana.

The Hon'ble Chairman directed the concerned officer to apply for the technical courses and connect the scheme with Skill India in coordination of DPM, NRLM, Hisar.

Item No. 29 Digital India- Public Internet Access Programme- providing Common Service Centre in each Gram Panchayat.

The concerned officer appraised the house about the scheme and the Hon'ble Chairman directed the concerned to motivate the Rural people to take the maximum benefit of the CSC Centre so that their visit to City for routine work which are available on these centres may be minimized.

Item No. 30 Smart City Mission

Does not relate to Hisar District.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

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
